Show me

For toddlers, point to your nose and say "nose". Say "show me your nose". Do this for different parts of the body or clothing. For older children, play Simon says (or 'mummy says')

Try some of these activities when you're in the car, at the park, visiting a museum, at the shops...



Numbers

Choose an item 'to spot' and count how many of it you see, e.g. dogs, buses, surfboards etc.

Photo Story

Take pictures of your child out and about. When you get home, print some out (or draw your own). Make a story about what you've done. *Can your child use it to tell someone else what they did?*



Snap!

Give your child an item and ask them to find something that is the same colour, or shape, or size. They could say 'snap' each time. Name the item the child has found and say what's the same.
