

Course title: Creative Paperworks Virtual Session	
Course duration: 2 hours x 1 weeks	Learner group: This course is for mothers and fathers (carers) with children aged 5+ years. Adults can only attend with a child, will participate fully in the activity and supervise their children throughout. Group size not to exceed 24, with no more than 2 children per adult. Contact Partnership Manager/Curriculum Leader if group exceeds specified sizes.
This course is designed to: Support interaction, provide quality time for families to have fun and learn together, strengthen relationships, build confidence and extend communication. Families will extend knowledge, work together, be creative and produce a project to take home.	
Content will include all/some of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make something either 2D or 3D from paper – ideas may include greeting cards, printed wrapping paper or seasonal projects. • Learner will be encouraged to explore new creative and design ideas. • Work together as a family. • Explore new ways of expressing creative potential. • Building relationships within the family/community. 	
What learners will need to bring to the session: Laptop, tablet or Smart phone with the Zoom app installed. There is no subscription required. Learners will be given a list of items required for the course, a week before the course starts	
Other requirements: Group Size: max 8 families The learner will be contacted prior to the session to complete an enrolment form over the phone, and to receive instructions about the link to enter the online session	Progression: FEML (Family English, Maths and Language) courses. Courses run at Kent Adult Education centres and other educational establishments.
