

Course title: Stepping Up into Primary with Crafts Virtual Session through Zoom

Course duration:

1 x 2 hour session

Note

The parents/carers spend the whole session with the children

Learner group:

This course is for mothers and fathers (carers) with children aged 3/4 years. Adults can only attend with a child, will participate fully in the activity and supervise their children throughout. Group size not to exceed 24 with no more than 2 children per adult. Contact partnership manager if group exceeds specified sizes.

This course is designed to:

Support interaction, provide quality time for families to have fun and learn together, strengthen relationships, build confidence and extend communication. Enable parents/carers to support their children to be school ready.

The families will extend knowledge of the skills required for starting school.

Content will include all/some of the following:

- Salt dough making
- Letter and sounds recognition.
- Listening activities and games
- Making a caterpillar number line to improve number recognition
- Lunch plate activity
- Building relationships within the family/community.

What learners will need to bring to the session:

Laptop, tablet or Smart phone with the Zoom app installed. There is no subscription required. Please wear old clothes as there is a messy craft activity.

A list of required items will be emailed to learners a week before the course starts

Other requirements: Max 8 families The learners will be contacted prior to the session to complete an enrolment form over the phone, and to receive instructions about the link to enter the online session Progression: FEML (Family English, maths and Language) courses. Courses run at Kent Adult Education centres, and other educational establishments.
