

# **English**

Throughout the term we will be looking at the following books - Out and About Poetry, Windy Way Home, How to catch a Rainbow, The North Wind and the Sun, One Rainy Day, The Nativity and A Christmas Present.

The children will use these stories each week to deepen their learning of our topics. And to use them to encourage their independent writing using the words and pictures from each story book.



### Maths

This term, the children will be learning the place value of numbers up to 10 and addition and subtraction.

This involves writing numbers as digits and words, exploring 2d and 3d shapes, They will learn how to complete addition and subtraction number sentences using the part, part whole method. The children will also develop their reasoning and mathematical word problem skills.



### Art and DT

This term, the theme is art inspired by the artist Berndnaut Smilde's moving cloud installations. The children will be exploring ways of making temporary clouds using flour or more permanent cloud sculptures using cloud dough. We will also be making kites and a range of weather related artwork.

### Discovery

This term we will be learning about Geography. We will be exploring how weather changes across the UK and around the world. We will also look at the history of the wind and how we have learnt to measure weather over time. We will be looking at seasonal changes through the Term.
