Maths

This term the children will continue with their learning about addition and subtraction. They will use their understanding of number bonds to 10 to help them solve additions and subtractions that cross a Ten.

The children will also explore 2D and 3D shapes. They will begin by naming and describing their properties, before learning to draw 2D shapes accurately, identify lines of symmetry and create and continue patterns with 2D and 3D shapes.

Art

This term, the children will be exploring colour mixing. They will learn about the three primary colours and how these can be combined to create a range of secondary colours. The children will experiment with different artistic techniques to create texture and layers to their artwork.

English

This term the children will begin by learning about the features of instruction writing. They will use their understanding of word classes to identify the use of time adverbials, imperative verbs and adverbs. They will also use Talk4Writing to practice narrative writing and letter writing.

In Guided Reading sessions, the children will continue to develop their fluency in blending, expression and comprehension skills.

In SPaG lessons, the children will explore word classes, including verbs and adverbs. They will also look at the use of commas in a list and to include extra information in a sentence.

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Music

In music this term the children will be learning a range of Christmas carols in preparation for our Carols on the Playground performance at the end of term.

They will apply their knowledge of finding the beat to ensure that they keep in time when singing as a group.

Knowledge and Understanding the World

This term the children will be comparing the Jewish celebration of Hannukah to the Christian celebration of Christmas. They will explore the similarities and difference between these two festivals and the beliefs of these two faiths.

Science

This term, the children will be building upon their understanding of the three states of matter (solid, liquid and gas) and how we can affect changes between these states – for example freezing and melting.

They will also investigate what happens when different liquids are combined to make a mixture, including exploring what happens when oil and water mix and how combining liquids can form bubbles.

P.E

This term the children will be learning Dance during their P.E sessions.

They will explore a range of movement types and think about how to make use of the space around them when performing.

The children will play with tempo and shape when creating simple dance routines both solo and in groups.

Uniform

As the weather is beginning to turn colder, please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat in school every day.

Please make sure that PE kits are returned to school ready for Tuesday.

Jumpers and cardigans have already started to be misplaced – please make sure that these are clearly labelled as this makes it much easier to return them to their owners!

Reading

Thank you for continuing to read with your child at home every day – this is particularly important in developing the ability to read fluently and therefore understand what has been read.

Children will continue to bring home photocopies of their Phonics reading book every week, please can we ask that these are returned by Friday ready to be swapped for the new ones.

Homework

A new Home Discovery grid will be sent home on Friday, with a new set of activities to choose from linking to this term's topic.

Each week, your child needs to select a new activity to complete, so that by the end of term they will have completed 7 activities. These can be recorded in the book or posted onto the Facebook group.
