Remember when your child walks or cycles to school, this all counts towards green travel and we could win prizes for the school. Thank you for your support





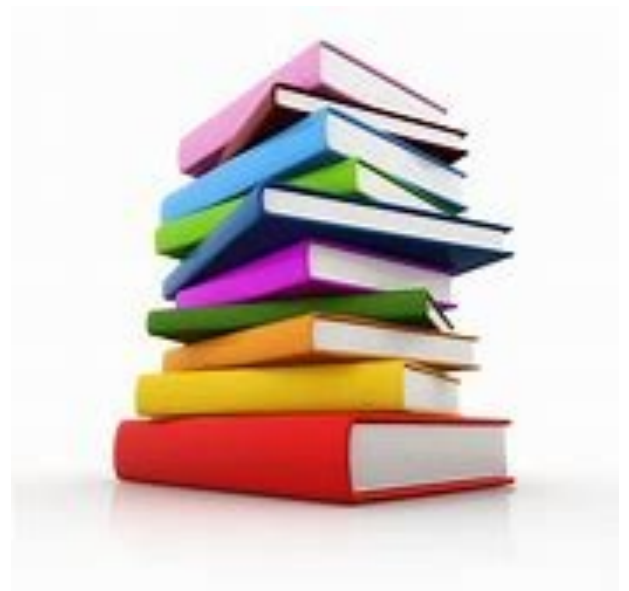
World Book Day 2020
