
<u>Geography</u>

Interconnected world teaches the children lots of essential skills and geographical knowledge. The children have the opportunity to learn about compass points and four and six-figure grid references. They also will get to learn about the tropics and the countries, climates and culture of North and South America.

Children will also get to conduct an enquiry to prove a hypothesis, gathering data from maps and surveys before drawing conclusions.

Through the different tasks set they will use a high level of new language. They will also follow the Talk for Writing process to help them structure their writing.

The children will begin to develop their use of language and writing for a purpose.
