### PE-Games



Over the fourth term this year the children will be looking at the skills they need to develop as a dancer. They will explore dancing to different music and developing individual routines.

# <u>English</u>

Over the term, the children will focus their writing based on their topic. They will begin with creating character description of a character connected to the Ancient Greeks and end the term with writing a creative narrative. They will follow the talk for writing process to support their writing.

Through the different tasks set they will use a high level of language. The children will continue to develop their use of language and writing for a purpose.

# Maths

During term 4, Year 5 will continue to build on their knowledge of multiplication and division. Children will also begin to apply their knowledge of the four operations to their learning of decimals, percentages, perimeter and area.

#### $\mathcal{D}\mathcal{T}$

This Design Technology project teaches children about pneumatic systems. They experiment with pneumatics before designing, making and evaluating a pneumatic machine that performs a useful function.

## <u>History</u>

This term the children will explore the fascinating Ancient Greeks!

This project teaches children about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the Classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.

# Knowledge and understanding of the world

This term in RE, the children will be exploring what is known as a 'big question' which is: 'What would Jesus do? Can we live by the values of Jesus in the twenty-first century?'

#### Uniform
