Discovery

- Play basic games with a ball.


Topic Web **Dinosaur Planet**



Maths

In maths, we will begin to explore and understand numbers up to 50. With these numbers, we will be understanding their value, counting in tens, and finding one more/ one less. We will also work on our number line skills, using them to estimate numbers. Later in the term we will begin learning to measure length, volume and capacity.


The children will also develop their reasoning and mathematical word problem skills.
