### **English**

Following the Green Park's Talk for Writing approach, children will develop their language and writing style around descriptive writing and poetry this term.

#### **Maths**

Following the White Rose Scheme, children will build on their knowledge of place value and apply it to new learning around the topics Decimals and Money.

# **Religious Education**

Children will focus on exploring on 'What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong?'

#### Science

During term 5 the children will have the opportunity to investigate the water cycle and the habitats around rivers and mountains.

There will be a focus on identification and classification of different animals/ plants that settle in our local rivers and on further afield mountains!

Children will also participate in some wonderful scientific learning on our annual Science Day this term. This will take place on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May.

### **Art & Design**

In Art and Design this term children will explore and apply techniques that artists use when composing landscape images, such as colour and atmosphere.



This project teaches children about the characteristics and features of rivers and mountain ranges around the world, including a detailed exploration of the ecosystem and processes that shape them and the land around them.

#### Music

In Music this term children will be exposed to the genre pop! The unit of work is focused around one song: Blackbird by the Beatles.

### **Physical Education**

In PE this term Kensington will be working on their athletic skills ready to support them in taking part in our yearly Sports day. Regents Class will be continuing their swimming lessons and building their confidence in the water.

## Spanish (MFL)

Children will continue to develop their Spanish language by looking at how to say certain actions in Spanish and learning Spanish vocabulary around the body.

### Computing

Children will explore designing, writing and debugging programs.

### Geography

Part of the term the children will explore the journey of a river. There will be a focus on key features of a river and the different stages it takes on its journey. The children will explore how rivers have been used to benefit settlements nearby and how they have physically changed our landscapes. They will take a particular focus at looking at rivers within our local area.

Part of the term the children will explore mountains. They will discover and research the different types of mountains and how they are shown on a map. Throughout the term the children will be learning lots of new topic vocabulary!
