

English

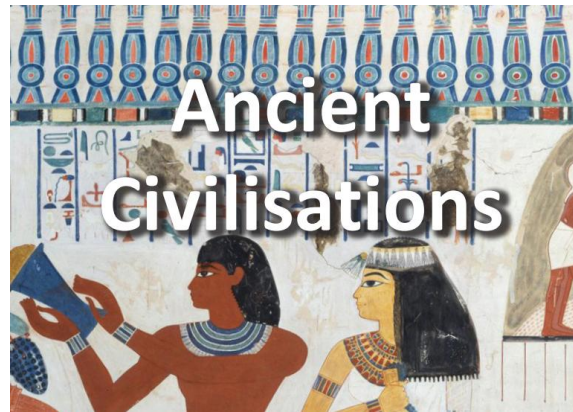
Over the term, the children will focus their writing based on their topic. They will begin with creating a diary entry.

Through the different tasks set they will use a high level of descriptive language. They will also follow the Talk for Writing process to help them structure their writing.

The children will continue to develop their use of language and writing for a purpose.

Maths

Children will continue to develop their fluency of the times tables. They will also apply their knowledge of the four operations to the topic 'Fractions and Decimals'.



History

This term we are going to explore a project that teaches the children about the history of the world's first ancient civilisation. We will focus specifically on Ancient Sumer and Ancient Egypt.

The children will develop their skills as a historian by learning from different sources and exploring artefacts!

PE

Over the term; half the class will be going swimming where they will develop confidence in the water whilst knowing how to remain safe. The other class will work on their gymnastic and dance skills.

RE

This term in RE, the children will be exploring what is known as a 'big question' which is: 'How do people from religious and non-religious communities celebrate key festivals?'

DT

Tomb Builders

This project teaches children about simple machines, including wheels, axles, inclined planes, pulleys and levers, exploring how they helped ancient builders to lift and move heavy loads.
