This term our topic has been 'Superheroes in Disguise', where we discovered that real-life superheroes are all around us in our community. The children were excited to learn about the four emergency services: the police, fire service, ambulance service and coastguard and the important role they play in keeping us safe.

We talked about when to call 999, who to ask for, and what to say in an emergency, helping the children understand how to stay safe and seek help if they ever need it. The children showed great curiosity and asked thoughtful questions about how emergency services help people.

We also explored the wider theme of 'People Who Help Us', learning about a variety of important roles within our community. Throughout the term, the children fully embraced imaginative play, enjoying opportunities to role play as dentists, vets, hairdressers, police officers, firefighters, lollipop people, builders and teachers. It has been wonderful to see their confidence, communication and teamwork skills grow through these experiences.

A real highlight of the term was our special visits from the police and fire service. The children loved meeting real-life community heroes, learning about their equipment and asking lots of questions about their jobs.

Another exciting experience was our visit to Little Seaside Town, where the children used their imaginations brilliantly across the different themed areas.

They demonstrated fantastic creativity, storytelling and collaboration skills.

We finished the term in style with our Valentine's Friendship Disco, celebrating kindness, friendship and all the wonderful relationships we have built in Palace Class this term.
