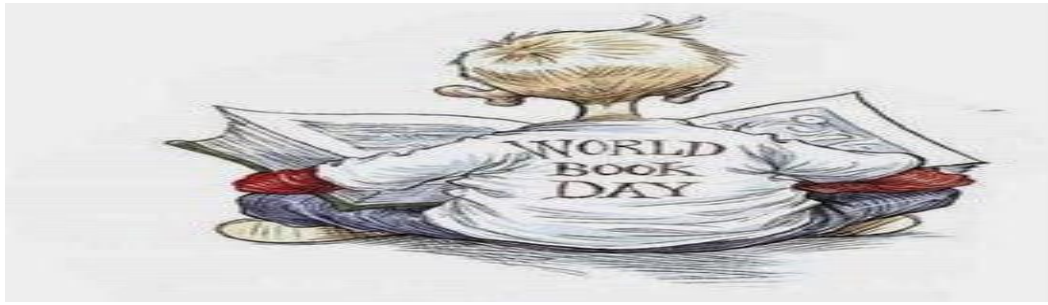
The Easter Parade promises to be a wonderful event. The creations I've seen already have been wonderful and it's lovely to see the children exploring their artistic abilities.
