This term we are going to explore a project that teaches the children about locating map features using a range of methods. They will then apply these skills to a local study. The children love exploring places close to them!

## Maths



In maths this term the children will be consolidating what they have learnt around place value and apply it to decimals, negative numbers and measurement. There will also be a focus on shape and position & direction.

## Art

This term to children will be following the topic Nature's Art. This project teaches children about the genre of land art. They will work outdoors to sketch natural forms and explore the sculptural potential of natural materials.

## Knowledge and understanding of the world

This term in RE, the children will be exploring what is known as a 'big question' which is: What difference does it make to believe in Ahimsa and grace?

### Uniform

All clothing needs to be labelled clearly please, especially jumpers/cardigans. PE will take place every week, unless otherwise stated, so please ensure your child arrives in full PE kit on Monday.
