Year 6	Silver Gate	lower playground

Children should be dropped off and picked up from these areas, which will be clearly marked to guide you to the right place.

After Transition Week, children will return to their current classes and continue entering through their usual gates until the end of the term.

- Current Year 4 moving to Year 5: Friday 3rd July at 2.30pm
- Current Year 5 moving to Year 6: Monday 29th June at 2.30pm
