Next week we are going to read the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar and we have lots of exciting things planned. The children will create their own caterpillars from playdoh, help to count all of the fruit that he ate, learn about the life cycle of a butterfly and will learn the song "There's a tiny caterpillar on a leaf!" so we apologise in advance for the singing!

We have been learning these sounds in class. We are now trying to build and write some 3 sound words (eg; sat)
s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d,
g, c, k and e

In Maths we have been learning to create repeating patterns (red, blue, red, blue). The children have enjoyed doing this and it would be lovely if they could show you a pattern at home.
